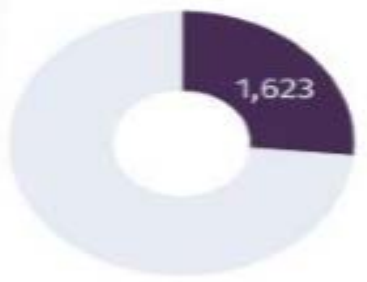

Who is Homeless in Clark County, WA?

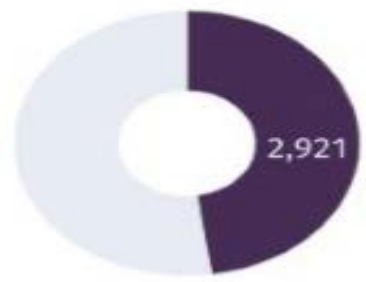
The **3,979** households who were homeless in Clark County during 2019 contained **6,117** people. Of these people...



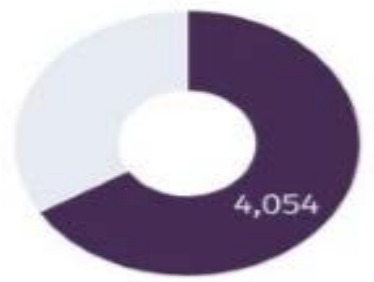
1/4 identified as children under 18



1/3 identified as people of color



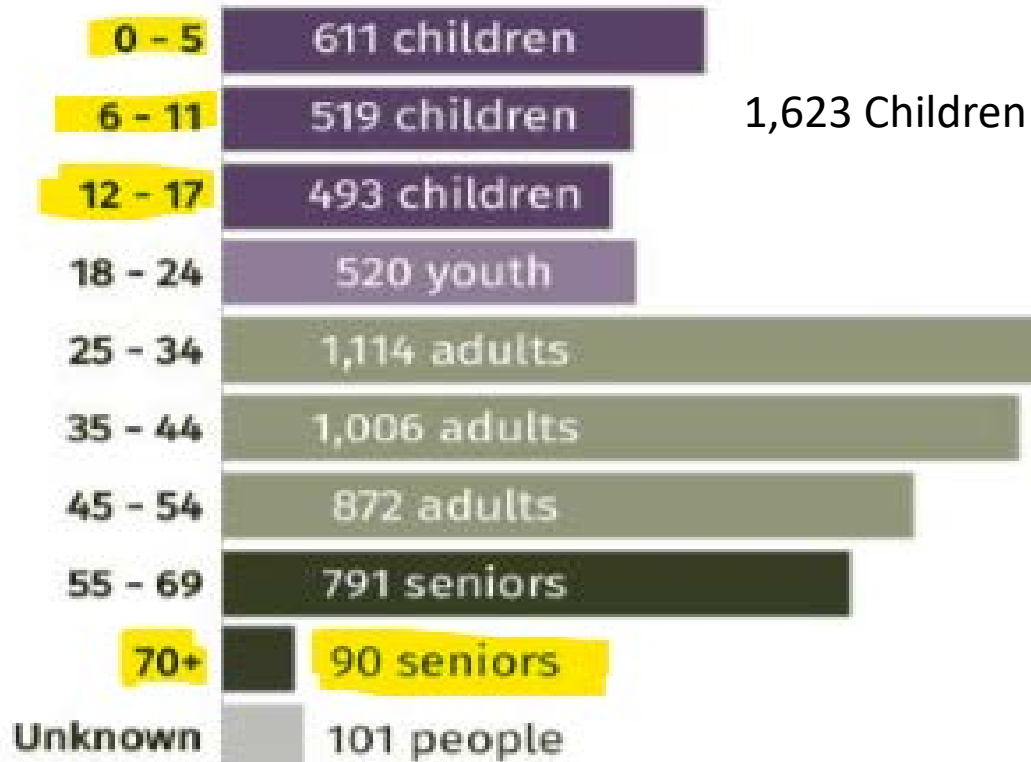
1/2 identified as women or non-binary



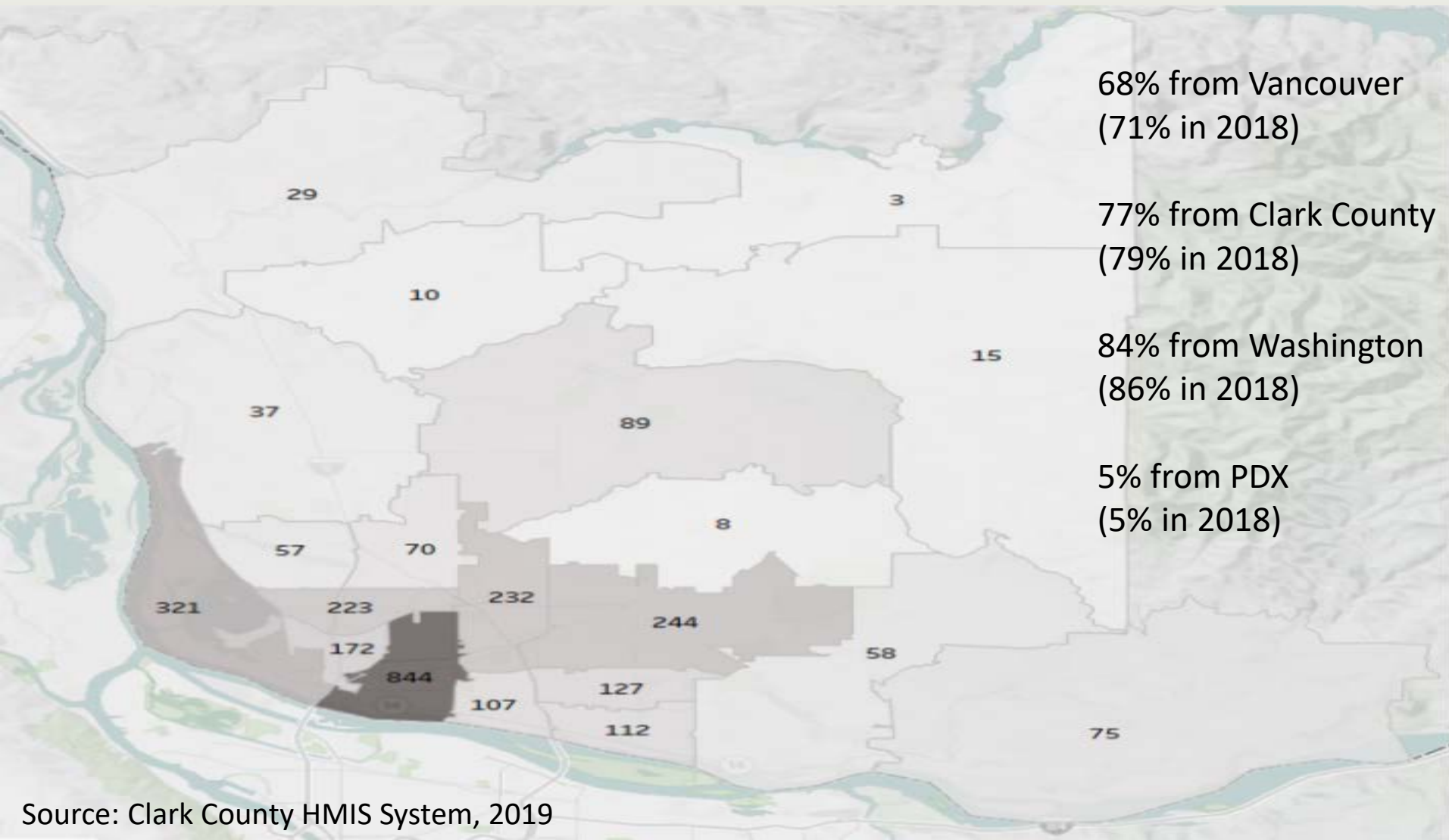
2/3 were newly homeless

HAP Outcomes

Prioritize people who are unsheltered:

Housing Type	2019 % Unsheltered	Trend compared to Baseline at 70%
Emergency Shelter	70%	+/-
Transitional Housing	57%	-
Rapid Re-Housing	90%	+
Permanent Supportive Housing	83%	+



Emergency Shelter

Percent of households in emergency shelter exiting to permanent housing.

2017 Baseline: 20%

2019: 30%

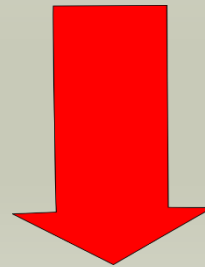


Rapid Re-housing

Increase the number of Rapid Re-housing households that exit to permanent housing.

2017 Baseline: 83%

2019: 72%

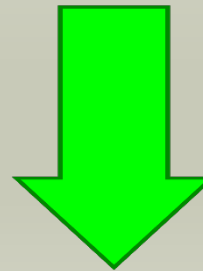


Rapid Re-housing

Reduce the average number of days it take to house a household in supportive housing.

2017 Baseline: 61 Days

2019: 29 Days

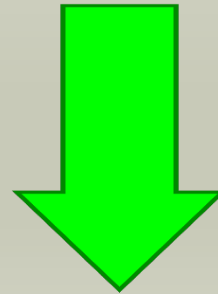


Permanent Supportive Housing

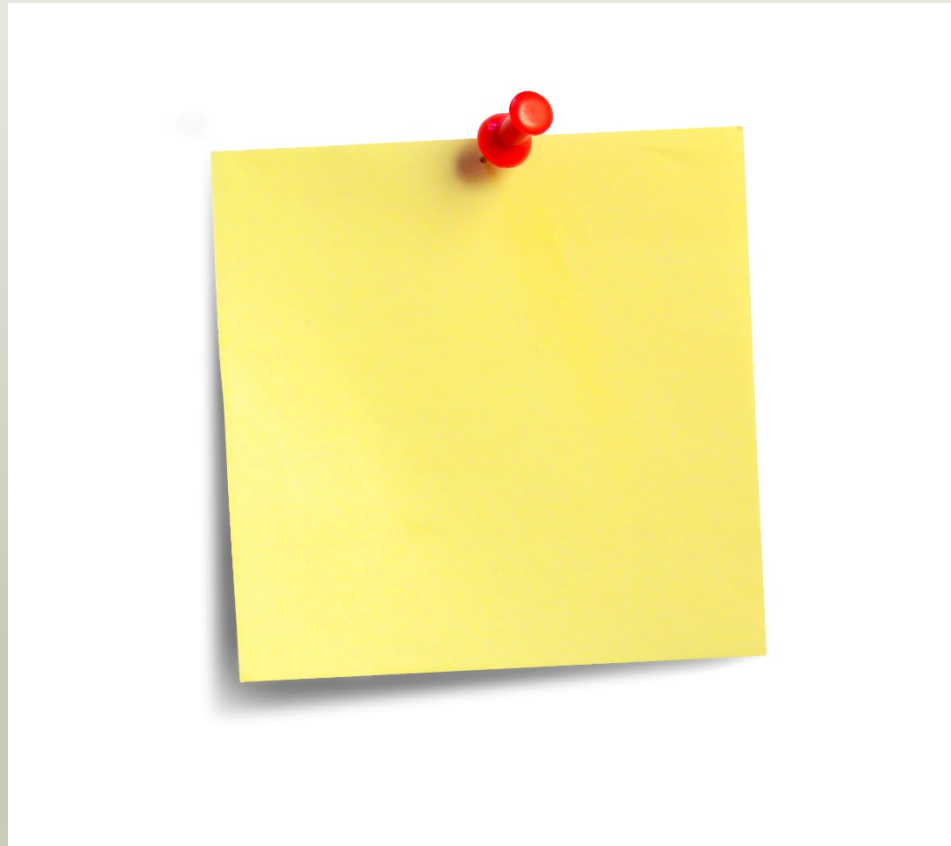
Reduce the average number of days it take to house a household in supportive housing.
