#### Andy Silver, Council for the Homeless: Continuum of Care (CoC) Steering Committee

The CoC Steering Committee was formed as part of our process of meeting HUD's requirements for CoCs across the country to formalize their structures and operations. The Steering Committee is charged with monitoring and evaluating funded projects and evaluating community needs, trends, and opportunities.

The committee held its first policy vote. In order to improve the rate that people exiting shelter access housing before reaching their shelter time limit, 50% of our community's rapid rehousing openings will be prioritized for people existing shelter.

Another steering committee focus is a convening a process to determine shared vision, goals, and outcomes within the homeless services system. Kevin Hiebert is facilitating a community engagement process to inform this work.
