


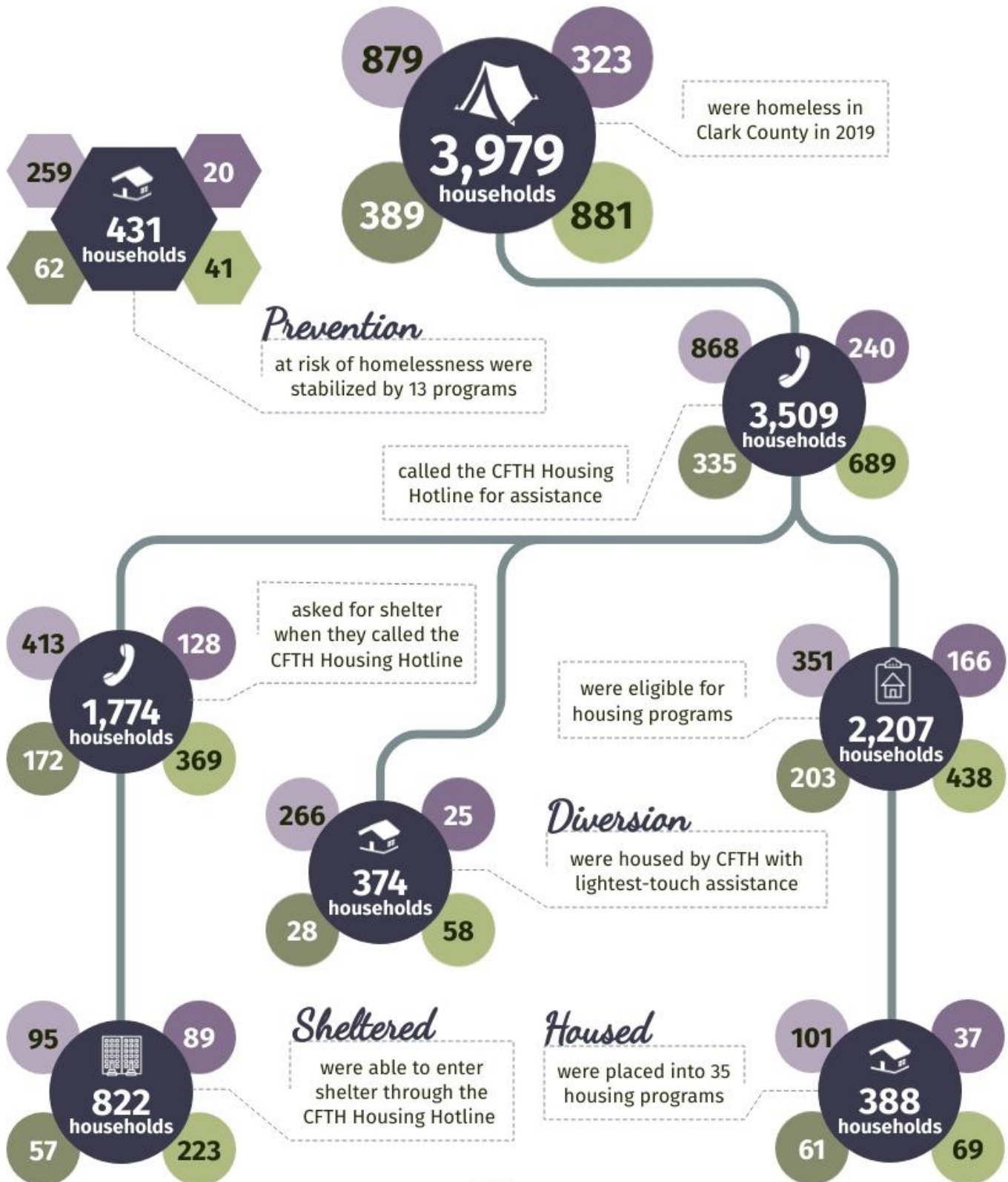

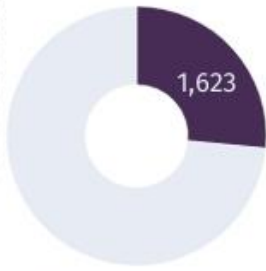

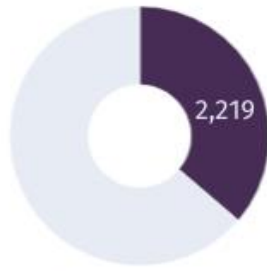
Who is Homeless in Clark County, WA?

The **3,979** households who were homeless in Clark County during 2019 contained **6,117** people. Of these people...

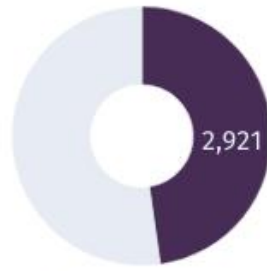

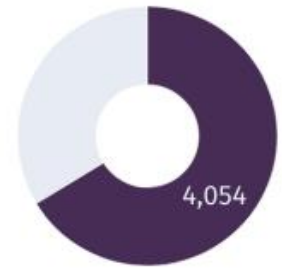

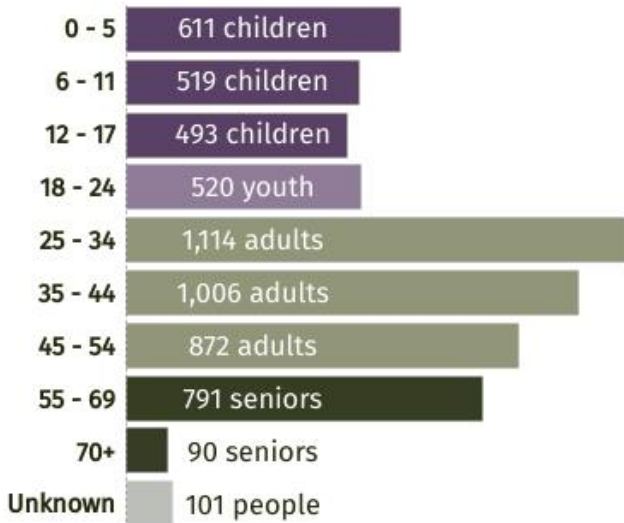

Housing Agencies
