



CFTH is a HUD Designated Collaborative Applicant for Clark County, WA:

Eligible applicants for this role could be an one of the following agencies:

- Instrumentality of state or local government
- Local government
- Nonprofit (like CFTH)
- State
- Public Housing Authority (PHA)

In Clark County, CFTH is eligible because of its status as a nonprofit and has been designated by the Continuum of Care (CoC), which is directed by a steering committee, to serve as the HUD Collaborative Applicant.

Because CFTH is the designated applicant, our agency may submit a project application to HUD for housing and/or services (on behalf of the Continuum of Care providers in Clark County).

Following are the responsibilities of CFTH as a Collaborative Applicant:

- Submits the Consolidated Application
- Applies for CoC planning funds on behalf of the CoC
- Participates in the development of the governance charter with the CoC

Following is the relationship that CFTH as a Collaborative Applicant has to the CoC:

- Acts on behalf of the CoC when applying to HUD for grants
- All responsibilities assigned to the collaborative applicant have to be documented in the CoC's governance charter
- The CoC retains its duties related to planning and prioritizing need such as having the authority to sign a grant agreement with HUD

Following are the attributes of the Consolidated Application which is submitted by CFTH on behalf of the CoC annually:
