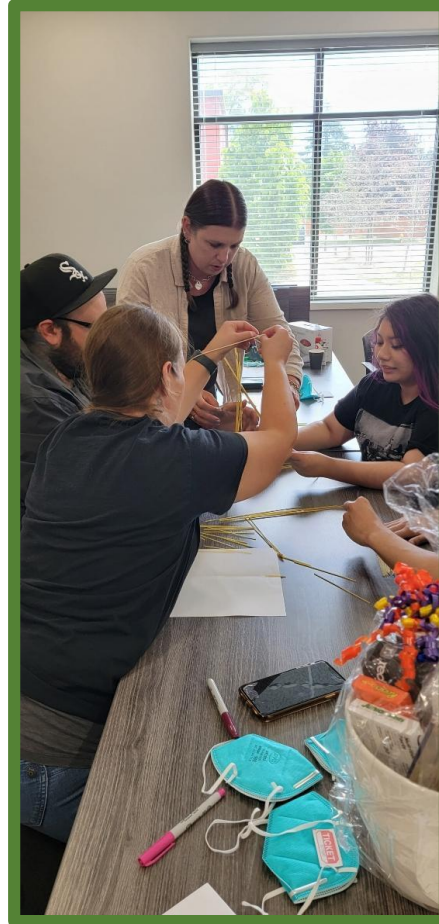
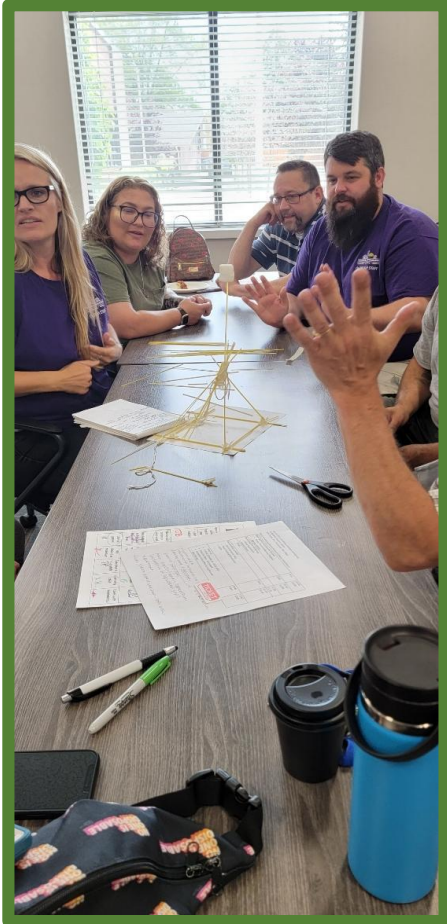

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Coordinated Outreach Accomplishments



- Coordinated outreach has engaged with 265 people this year.

Out of those 265

- 80 were housed
- 74 were housed, without ongoing subsidy
- Average period from entry into coordinated outreach to a housing exit was 37 day.
