


## STATE OF HOMELESSNESS IN CLARK COUNTY

The data below illustrates the state of homelessness in Clark County, Wash., in 2024.




**EXPERIENCED HOMELESSNESS AT ANY POINT IN 2024**  
2024=3,804 / 2023=4,447




**CALLED CFTH HOUSING HOTLINE FOR ASSISTANCE**

2024=4,997 / 2023=5,509




**ASKED FOR SHELTER**

2024=1,526 / 2023=1,370





**ASSESSED FOR HOUSING PROGRAMS**
